De Bortoli DB Sparkling Classic

Glass 800 Bottle 3,200

Crisp, charming and very classy. A refreshing, easy drinking sparkling wine with fresh fruit, hints of citrus and creamy bubbles. NSW Australia.

Jean Pierre Sparkling Rosé

3,500

Clean citrus and floral notes are complexed with fresh cream and bread dough aromas. The fine bubbles provide a creamy texture, while the delicate acidity balances the fresh fruit. South Eastern Australia

G.H. Mumm Cordon Rouge

Bottle 9,000 1/2 Bottle 4,500

The nose reveals initial aromas of ripe fresh fruit (white and yellow peaches, apricots), tropical notes (lychee and pineapple). It then opens up with the fragrance of vanilla before developing notes of milky caramel, breadcrumbs and yeast, culminating in aromas of dried fruit and honey. An explosion of freshness in the mouth, followed by strong persistence. The complex aromas of fresh fruit and caramel perpetuate the intensity. Champagne, France.

Bollinger Special, Pinot Noir/Chardonnay/Meunier

20,900

Medium light yellow colour. Toasted cashew nut bouquet, with lovely balance of fruit and artefact. The palate is very intense and serious, nutty and toasty and long. The finish is clean and dry and the aftertaste is savoury. Champagne, France.

WHITE

Three Pillars The Gourmet Chardonnay, Chardonnay

Glass 800 Bottle 3,200

This Chardonnay shows lovely fresh fruit flavours of peach, grapefruit and pear with a hint of apricot and is complemented by floral aromas of honeysuckle and jasmine. The palate is fresh and lively and will complement a vast array of foods. South Australia.

Matetic Corralillo, Sauvignon Blanc

Glass 900 Bottle 3,500

Pale bright yellow with green hues. The nose offers herbal and citric aromas such as grapefruit alongside tropical fruits such as mango and papaya. In the mouth it offers a fresh and juicy acidity, great volume with an elegant and balanced long finish. San Antonio Valley, Chile.

Geoff Merrill Pimpala Road, Chardonnay

3,500

The colour is a fresh mid straw with youthful green hues. The aroma shows lovely fresh citrus fruit with a hint of creamy oak, ripe apple and honeydew melon. The palate is generous early in the mouth then displays its tight structure and clean acidity on the finish. South Australia.

Château Bellefontaine Blanc, Grenache Blanc/Ugni Blanc/Clairette

4,700

Shiny gold colour with the sense of green. Hint of white Fruits. It has a long fresh after-taste, flower of Acacia, exotic passion fruits, etc. It has a long fresh after-taste, thanks to well balanced acidity. Costières de Nîmes, France.

Mitolo Jester Vermentino, Vermentino

5,200

The aromatics are all about freshness and purity with powerful pithy, lemon citrus characters and more subtle tropical notes of melon and pungent papaya. Clean, grapefruit citrus flavours dominate with tropical undertones of melon. The palate is bright and fresh with a savoury, saline edge yet still a lovely soft, mouth filling quality and the faintest dusting of chalky structure. South Australia.

Shaw and Smith, Sauvignon Blanc**5,400**

Bright and aromatic with notes of grapefruit, nashi pear and nettles. On the palate there is intense flavour with fresh, limey fruit, mouthwatering acidity and remarkable purity. South Australia.

Lecher Festwein, Grüner Veltliner**5,600**

Fruity spicy fragrance with apple and pear, hint of pepper. Mature fruit on the palate, elegant refined finish. Friendship wine with Lech (Austria), Kampen (Germany), Beaver Creek (USA) and Happo-One. Kleinriedenthal Austria

Shaw and Smith, M3 Chardonnay**6,800**

A beautifully complex nose showing lemon, apple and white peach along with biscuit notes. The palate displays trademark M3 elegance and restraint with an extra dimension of creaminess through the finish. A wine of depth and concentration that balances generous fruit flavours with savoury characters and crisp acidity. South Australia.

Régnard Meursault "Terres Blanches" 2010, Chardonnay**19,500**

A bouquet of honey is supported by light woody undertones which add elegance and subtlety. The palate is round, full and elegant with underlying aromas of citrus fruit and vanilla. Full, round and powerful, this wine has all the hallmarks of a classic top quality Meursault. Bourgogne, France.

Cullen Kevin John, Chardonnay**22,000**

Intense citrus, pear and tropical fruit aromas are enhanced by the perfect oak treatment. Rich and complex, combining fresh pear, grapefruit, lime and papaya flavours. Wonderfully balanced by the citrusy acidity. Western Australia.

RED**Three Pillars The Gourmet Shiraz****Glass 800 Bottle 3,200**

This Shiraz is a medium bodied wine, combining fresh blackberry flavours with gentle floral aromas. The finish is smooth, with subtle vanilla and cedar oak adding a savoury quality to the wine. This is an elegant wine that will complement a vast array of foods.

Koyle Gran Reserva, Cabernet Sauvignon**Glass 900 Bottle 3,600**

Deeply colored, with plenty of black fruit character, showing a great presence of currant and blueberry, with hints of exotic spice and cedar. This Cabernet is a full expression of origin, showing a real grip of acidity and mineral notes. Ripe tannins are solid and velvety, and come together beautifully, with a silky and balanced finish. D.O. Colchagua Valley, Chile.

Domaine De Pierredon Cotes du Rhone, Grenache/Mourvedre**4,800**

This wine is medium bodied, nicely balanced and smooth. It displays very nice juicy blueberry and cassis flavors with well integrated gentle oak. A hint of espresso and a little black cherry on the back palate. The finish is dry and its dusty oak tannins stick around for quite a while. Cotes du Rhone, France.

Lecher Festwein, Rotweincuvee**5,500**

Lively fragrance of dark berries, black cherries, spices and delicate toasted aromas. Balanced, powerful and full-bodied on the palate. A wine with finesse and a long finish. Friendship wine with Lech (Austria), Kampen (Germany), Beaver Creek (USA) and Happo-One. Grossnondorf, Austria

Glaetzer Wallace, Shiraz/Grenache **6,500**

A blend of Shiraz and Grenache, the medium to deep garnet-purple colored 2013 Wallace opens with aromas of warm mulberries, kirsch and plum preserves interplaying with underlying smoked bacon, cloves and cinnamon stick suggestions. Full-bodied with a good amount of lively black and red fruit flavors, it has a soft tannic profile and long, pepper-laced finish. Barossa Valley, Australia.

Shaw and Smith Shiraz **6,700**

The 2013 is a perfumed Shiraz with aromatics of florals and cherry. The palate shows bright fruit in the red fruits spectrum and spice notes of dried herbs including thyme. Natural tannins and a graphite-like earthiness contribute to a savoury core that underpins the great depth and complexity of this wine. South Australia.

Aljibes Petit Verdot 2008 **7,900**

This wine has an intense purple color with aromas of mediterranean forest, incense and exotic spices. Smooth, balanced and long on the palate, with ripe tannins. Varietal characteristic flavor of high concentration. Castilla y Leon, Spain

Cullen Diana Madeline 2011 (Bordeaux Blend: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc) **18,000**

Displays complexity and vitality with layers of well ripened dark fruits highlighted by nuances of blackcurrants, plums and mulberries. Athletic structure and fruit driven, the palate presents blackcurrant and mulberry fruits finishing with fine grained tannins. Subtle layers of complexity arise from fruit harvested at the pinnacle of ripeness. Margaret River, Western Australia.

Chateau Calon Segur 2007, Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot **30,000**

An elegant mix of sweet cherry and redcurrant with earthy undertones. A medium bodied Bordeaux with round spicy tones and made with finesse-filled French style. Bordeaux Medoc AOC Saint-Estephe, France.

Chateau Palmer 2007, Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon/Petit Verdot **90,000**

Nose with hints of vanilla, raspberry, redcurrant, and bay leaf, with understated oak. Beautiful balance between alcohol and tannin on the palate. Concentrated with rich tannin and attractive freshness. Bordeaux Medoc AOC Margaux, France.
